ECONOMY AND MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT

The Department of Economics and Management was established in 2000 on the basis of the reorganization of the Department of Economic Theory, in connection with the opening of the Faculty of Economics and Law.

In 2000 the department was headed by the candidate of economic science, associate professor - Balashov T.F., and since January 2011 the department has been headed by PhD, associate professor - Makovskaya N.V.

Currently, the staff of the Department includes 14 teachers, including 3 senior lecturers (Makovskaya N.V., Balashov T.F., Chegerova T.I.) and 1 Doctor of Economics (Makovskaya N.V.), 2 candidates of economic sciences (Chegerova T.I., Balashov T.F.). Work of the department is also provided by guest lecturers and PhD: S.S.Gnatyuk, N.S.Zheltok, N.A.Sergeychik, L.V.Narkevich, L.A.Samuseva, M.S.Aleksandrenok, M.A. Bezzubenko, V.S.Zharikov, A.I.Aleksandrov.

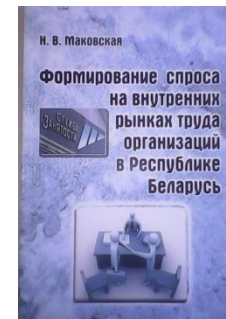
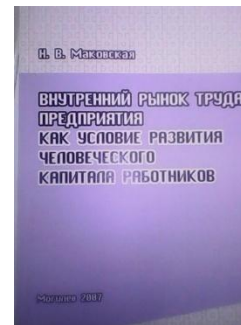


• ECONOMY AND MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT

- So far the chair prepares graduates in 4 specialties of an economic profile: "Public administration", "Economy and management at the enterprise", "Management" and "Business administration". 93 courses are taught at the department. Basic courses and special courses are: economic theory, economy of the organization (enterprise), accounting, management and marketing bases, etc.

Scientific activity of the department is presented by the following scientific directions:

- research of forms and methods of state regulation of market economy;
- research of the role of the state and local governing bodies in the conditions of market economy;
- analysis of the state of macroeconomic parameters of a labor market and social sphere of the Republic of Belarus. In the directions of scientific activity researches financed by the Belarusian republican fund of basic researches are carried out. As a result of scientific researches a number of monographs, manuals and scientific and methodical works are published.





ECONOMY AND MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT

At the Department scientific research on the topic: "The reaction of intra-wage policy to the changing economic situation: a comparative analysis of the Russian Federation and the Republic of Belarus" commissioned BRFFR (the supervisor of the project Makovskaya N.V.) was initiated.

The work of 2 scientific clubs is organized at the department:

1. Business school (N.A.Osipenko),

2. Business process management at the enterprise (I.V.Vasiljeva).

A team of students annually participates in the Open Championship "Youth Entrepreneurship" conducted on the basis of UO "BelSUT" Gomel and receives diplomas in the nomination for the best technological project. A mixed team of students "School of Business", "Business Process Management at the enterprise" clubs is involved in the competition of student teams from the Republic of Belarus for the best solution to a case in the framework of the "Cases about Belarusian business: development and introduction of business education."

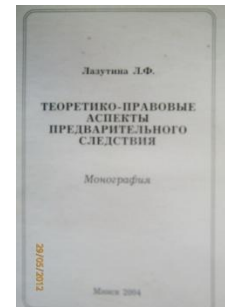


- 23 judicial disciplines are taught at the department.

- In 2002, the University opened the Regional Centre for Judicial Aid, which provides judicial information and counseling for the following categories of citizens: the unemployed; poor; members of large families; single mothers; disabled and others

- Social (consulting people with low income in the sphere of law in an oral form)
